RCI Foundation to Host a Two-Day Symposium on Sustainable Building

(Raleigh, NC) – The RCI Foundation, in an effort to better educate building design professionals on the growing green movement, is hosting a two-day symposium on sustainable building envelope design and construction. The *Symposium on Building Envelope Sustainability: The Future is in the Balance*, will be held at the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel in Washington DC from April 30 – May 1, 2009.
